Dear Ms. Byrne,

I would like to thank you for your communication of 1 December 2017, regarding the collection of certified emission reductions (CERs) generated after the sale of the wind farm by its owner. Your communication has been made available to the CDM Executive Board (the Board) in accordance with the relevant provision of the procedure for direct communication with stakeholders.<sup>1</sup>

I would like to inform you that as long as you remain a project participant to Project 4243: The Converging World Renewable Energy India Wind Farm Phase, you may receive CERs from this project, provided the secretariat receives such instruction from the focal point for scope (a) designated in the modalities of communication (MoC) valid at the time of forwarding.

I would also like to inform you that private contractual arrangements, such as the establishment of conditions for the designation or change of focal points or the purchase and/or sale of CERs or forwarding of CERs, are outside the scope of the CDM rules and regulations and the CDM Executive Board. Further, we have not come across any similar request in the past.
