



# VOLUNTARY CANCELLATION CERTIFICATE

## Reason for cancellation:

GVK Mumbai International Airport Ltd. (MIAL) is responsible for operating, managing, upgrading, modernizing and developing Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport (CSIA), Mumbai, India. MIAL is committed to reduce its business impact on climate change while maintaining sustainable business growth. Since 2012, MIAL has been participating in Airport Council International's (ACI) Airport Carbon Accreditation Programme for climate change mitigation & ensure sustainable development of CSIA, Mumbai. MIAL achieved ACA Level 1 (Mapping) in 2012 and subsequently upgraded its accreditation to ACA Level 2 (Reduction) in 2013, ACA Level 3 (Optimisation) in 2015 & 2016 and finally upgraded to ACA Level 3+ (Neutrality) in 2017 based on various initiatives taken for carbon reduction.

To further renew the highest accreditation level under this Programme, MIAL has decided to offset its Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 (staff business travel) emissions for the year 2017-18, by purchasing 99,800 Certified Emission Reductions (CERs). By offsetting the Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 (Staff business travel) emissions, MIAL will achieve the requirements of the Carbon Neutrality (Level 3+) of ACI Airport Carbon Accreditation Programme.
