Dear Sirs,

The project participants (PP) of the project activity 10261 (Oeste de Caucaia Landfill Project Activity, registered on 22-04-2016) will participate in the development of a new landfill project in a neighbour area that will likely lead to a proposed new project activity (proposed new PA).

In order to avoid misunderstandings in a likely validation of the proposed new PA in the near future, the PPs would like to request the following clarification.

Considering the clarification "New project activity in the same physical or geographical location at which a project activity whose crediting period has expired existed," version 02.0 (CDM-EB92-A02),

	<p>the the PP of the proposed new PA clarifies that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The existing project activity (existing PA or PA10261) has not expired (crediting period: 22 Apr 16 - 22 Apr 23, renewable); - The proposed new PA will be developed in an adjacent area but physically divided by a road and, therefore, not in the same area; - The proposed new PA (i) will not lead to the discontinuation or modification of the existing PA; and (ii) will not decrease the expected emission reductions or removals of the former PA; - The proposed new PA (i) will use the same measure (methane destruction) and will likely use the same technology (flares and delivery into a natural gas pipeline), but consider power generation (a different technology) too; and (ii) will not utilize any of the assets of the existing project (it is not part of the existing PA concession, will necessarily need to issue a new environmental license, it will use completely separated equipment and, it will have segregated O&M); and (iii) will utilize different resources type compared with the existing project; and (iv) will not decrease the expected emission reduction or removals of the former PA. - Although the PP (or affiliated companies) of the existing PA will participate in the proposed new PA, the capital structure of the proposed new PA, including shareholder ownership, is different when compared to the current equity participation in existing PA. <p>As not conditions in paragraph 8 and 9 of CDM-EB92-A02 are not met (due to condition 7(i) being not met), the PP of the new proposed PA confirm that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the proposed new PA is a completely new venture; and - the proposed new PA will not lead to the discontinuation or modification of the existing PA; and - the proposed new PA will not decrease the expected emission reductions or removals of the former PA. <p>Considering the clarifications above, it is the PP understanding that the proposed new PA shall be validated as a new CDM project.</p> <p>Would you be so kind to confirm if the PP understanding is correct? The PP remain obviously available to submit any additional information needed.</p> <p>Thank you very much.</p>
