This technical training workshop is meant to help DNAs to prepare for new carbon crediting opportunities and challenges under the Paris Agreement. It will discuss options for domestic crediting strategies and governance; methodological approaches including CDM transition; and corresponding adjustments including registry/reporting requirements. In a final session it will bring all these elements together in concrete case studies.

The workshop will be delivered by World Bank experts and build on experiences with piloting activities and capacity building initiatives.
