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The current situation in the area, and the type of facilities in which the CDM project is implemented, make a mix of circumstances that creates an unaffordable risk to our team leader assigned to the project assessment.

The project site is a Gold Mine in the Sahel region near to the north region of Malí and Niger borders, in which there is actually a big presence of terrorist groups and recent activities with several attacks causing deaths (particularly gold mines are a declared objective by this terrorist groups).

Given the recent attack to the gold mining site and other recent attacks in the north of the country, suspected presence near Ouaga city too, our people is concerned about security and life risk concerning the project site visit.

Please kindly check also that there is a declared emergency state in Burkina Faso due to these incidents that has been extended recently, as per the below news:
