Re: Addition of methodology AMS-I.K. to PoA 7014 as a post-registration change together with the renewal of the PoA


Dear Mr. Farmer,

I would like to thank you for your communication of 15 January 2020, requesting a direct communication with the UNFCCC secretariat following the publication of Ruling note: Rational for rejection for PRC-7014-004. Your communication has been made available to the CDM Executive Board (the Board) in accordance with the relevant provision of the procedure for direct communication with stakeholders.¹

I would like to inform you that the reasons and rationale for the final decisions by the Board are clearly furnished in paragraph 1(c) of the Ruling note: Rational for rejection for PRC-7014-004. Further, acknowledging the good intent of the coordinating/managing entity a way forward was given in paragraph 1(d) of the same document. However, if the ruling note is not clear, you as a coordinating/managing entity or your contracted designated operational entity may request a telephone call with the UNFCCC secretariat, in accordance with the “CDM project cycle procedure for programme of activities” (version 02.0) paragraph 164, by sending an email to cdmregistration@unfccc.int with the following subject line: “Request for Telephone call - Direct Communication - PoA No. 7014.” I would also like to inform you that the scope of such call is only to provide clarification on the ruling note.
