Ghana's Ministry of Information has introduced restrctions on movement (Accra and Kumasi are currently on lockdown), which makes it impossible to conduct these surveys and stove testing. It is not known when full freedom of movement will be re-instated or possible. We therefore request for guidance from the UNFCCC on an application for a temporary change to the Monitoring Plan. We are proposing the following for your consideration: Foregoing the scheduled stove testing and instead using the values that were used in the last Monitoring Report Foregoing the surveys and applying the survey results used in the last Monitoring Report complemented by some telephone surveys. These changes will allow the CPAs to deliver a monitoring report and then CERs in a way that is otherwise impossible using the current monitoring requirements. At this time of respiratory pandemic, financing improved cook stove access is a key public health concern.
