Dear Mr. Norstebo,

I would like to thank you for your communication of 16 March 2020, with regard to the ongoing monitoring activity for PoA 7359 in Kenya. Your communication has been made available to the CDM Executive Board (the Board) in accordance with the relevant provision of the procedure for direct communication with stakeholders.¹

Any temporary deviation from the registered monitoring plan would require you to follow the process of approval of temporary deviation. Without prejudice to any decision by the Board, you may submit a notification of change through a DOE to the secretariat by uploading a monitoring report describing the temporary deviation from the registered monitoring plan, including reference to the current coronavirus situation, as per paragraphs 168(a) and 169 of the “CDM project cycle procedure for programme of activities” (version 02.0). The request for temporary deviation may be submitted concurrently with a request for issuance that is based on the same monitoring plan.
