Dear Mr. Afyouni,

I would like to thank you for your communication of 10 May 2020, to include the recycling of post-consumer wood system as a project under UNFCCC project directory. Your communication has been made available to the CDM Executive Board (the Board) in accordance with the relevant provision of the procedure for direct communication with stakeholders.¹

Specific technologies/measures are not included as eligible activities or registered as CDM project activity. It is rather a project activity or a programme of activity that is registered applying an approved CDM methodology that includes those specific technologies/measures. Currently there is no methodology under consideration or approved by the Board that covers all aspects of wood waste recycling you wish to implement as a climate action. However, if you wish to propose a new methodology or a revision to an existing methodology for the Board to consider and approve, please submit the necessary documents to the UNFCCC secretariat,² considering decision 17/CP.7, paragraph 7(a)³ and decision 1/CMP.2, paragraphs 29 and 30.⁴ There is no fee payable to the UNFCCC secretariat for submission of a proposed new methodology. For an easy understanding of the scopes of available methodology you may also consult the CDM methodology booklet.⁵
