	solar electric cooker (ECOCA) that soley uses households' domestic solar energy.
	The updating of our PoA DD 7014 for our current Renewal of Crediting Period by, inter alia, adding solar electric cookers and a new generic CPA-DD in accordance with the latest version of AMS-I.E, means that all the biomass cook stoves being used by households that will receive solar electric cookers will be fully replaced. Thus, the new solar cookers will not be an addition to a household's biomass cook stoves, as they will be scrapped, and no 'stacking' will take place.
	The respective tracking and monitoring work of the CPA and the CME will allow the use of the solar electric cookers to be carefully recorded.
	In the PS-PoA, version 2.0., our reading of paragraph 167(b), where there are two options, option (ii) guided us with the text "Two different project activities are considered to be using the same technologies if they undertake the same course of action that results in the same kind of effect (e.g. two projects using the same management practice such as fuel switching) where we understand the same course of action is the cooking of food, using either biomass or solar electricity).
	Our clarification request to the Meth Panel (SSC 773), was considered at MP 81 where it was elevated to the EB (Para 41 "The MP recommended that the Board approve the clarification"). We understand that MP members were generally in favour of us being allowed to include CPAs with improved electric solar cookers into our PoA 7014. However, there was no consideration of this recommendation or a ruling at EB 106 in respect of our clarification request.
	As there was no ruling, or encouragement from the Board at EB 106 for us to use Para 295 of the PS for PoAs "to combine a request for approval of any types of changes to the registered CDM PoA with a request for renewal of the PoA period", this has now stalled the process of us completing our Renewal of Crediting Period submission.
	We now request the EB to guide our use of such a combined request in accordance with the "CDM project cycle procedure for programmes of activities", as this is the combination that we wish to use. Hence we have submitted this further communication to the EB for its consideration by circulation to its members, without awaiting the next formal meeting of the EB.
