## Wind Power Project in Madhya Pradesh by EnvironmentFirst-214

- 1. In accordance with paragraph 42 of the CDM Modalities and Procedures Decision 3/CMP.1) and paragraph 124 of the PCP PA, if the project participant wish so, this project activity may be resubmitted for validation and registration provided it meets the requirements for validation and registration.
- 2. The CDM-Executive Board decided to reject the proposed project activity on 26 May 2020, in accordance with the "*CDM project cycle procedure for project activities*" (PCP PA), version 02.0, paragraphs 110 and 116. Further, in accordance with paragraph 117 of the PCP PA, the ruling shall contain an explanation of the reasons and rationale for the final decision, which are as follows:
  - (a) The DOE (LGAI Tech. Center S.A.) failed to substantiate how it has validated the CDM prior consideration for the project activity in accordance with paragraph 41 of VVS PA, version 2.0.
  - (b) The relevant requirements are:
    - (i) VVS PA, version 2.0, paragraph 41 states that "For a proposed CDM project activity with a start date on or after 2 August 2008, the DOE shall confirm by referring to the list of prior consideration notifications from the UNFCCC CDM website and communication between the project participants, the secretariat and the host Party DNA, if the DNA exists, regarding the commencement of a new project activity and the intention to seek CDM status for the project activity, or referring to the UNFCCC CDM website, whether the PDD has been published within 180 days of the start date."
  - (c) The reasons and rationale for the final decisions are:
    - (i) The DOE failed to substantiate how it has validated the CDM prior consideration for the project activity in accordance with paragraph 41 of VVS PA, version 2.0, considering that the form submitted by the PP to UNFCCC on 12 May 2014 does not correspond to the project activity as described in the PDD and validated by the DOE due to difference in project title, technology, capacity, location and investor.
    - (ii) Further, the form dated 12 April 2014 as validated by the DOE was never submitted by PP to UNFCCC as part of prior consideration notification for the project activity.
- 3. In accordance with paragraph 42 of the CDM Modalities and Procedures Decision 3/CMP.1) and paragraph 124 of the PCP PA, if the project participant wish so, this project activity may be resubmitted for validation and registration provided it meets the requirements for validation and registration.
