COVER NOTE

1. Procedural background

- 1. The CDM Executive Board (hereinafter referred to as the Board) at its 106th meeting approved the workplan of the Board for 2020 and requested the secretariat to include in future versions of the workplan any new mandates arising from meetings and to provide an update on the status of work at each meeting.
- 2. This work is in line with the requests of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP) to the Board to continue its work to further improve the consistency, efficiency and transparency of its decision-making.

3. The workplan of the Board for 2020 provides an overview of the issues to be considered by the Board at each meeting during the year. This allows the Board to plan its work throughout the year, ensuring a balanced workload and an efficient use of meeting time.
