- Review requests for submitted requests for renewal of a crediting period which starts after the end of the second commitment period on 31 December 2020
- Regulatory gap caused by postponing of COP 26

Review Requests

- Several DOEs have received a review request for submitted requests for renewal of a crediting period which starts after the end of the second commitment period on 31 December 2020
- We requested a clear statement by AP that this issue will receive a weighing of 0 according to appendix 1 of the performance monitoring procedure
- AP report refers to the same annex without confirming classification under section IV (missing or ambiguous regulations/guidance results in weight = 0)
- We expect this confirmation to be given by this EB meeting
- We consider this as a purely 'political' issue

Regulatory gap - CDM beyond 2020

- We also want to highlight that the discussion around these requests for review and the regulatory gap jeopardizes the continuation of DOE business in total for Jan 2021 until CMP
- We hope that the EB can demonstrate its competence at this meeting and find an (interim) solution that enable continuation of CDM business at an anyway low level until COP 26 (and hopefully beyond)
