## Summary of the outcome of CDM-AP 87

---

- The CDM-AP held its 87<sup>th</sup> meeting from 1 to 4 September 2020, as a virtual meeting, and held an electronic consultation from 27 July to 14 August 2020;
- The CDM-AP considered 17 cases, of which 6 have been submitted to the Board.

## Summary of the outcome of CDM-AP 87

---

### The CDM-AP:

- a) Recognizing the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, recommends that the Board allow the provision related to paragraph 125 of the “CDM accreditation procedure” (ver.15.0) be applied in initial accreditation and re-accreditation assessments;
- b) Interacted with the DOE/AIE Coordination Forum Chair;
- c) Interacted with a group of nine lead assessors from the CDM accreditation roster of experts (ARoE) to exchange views on the implementation of the CDM accreditation requirements and on requests for clarifications on the “CDM accreditation standard” (ver. 07.0) and the “CDM accreditation procedure” (ver. 15.0).



The CDM-AP recommends that the Board

- a) Take note of this presentation;
- b) Take note of the meeting report of the 87<sup>th</sup> CDM-AP meeting and the electronic consultation held from 27 July to 14 August 2020;
- c) Consider the recommendation request from the CDM-AP;
- d) There will not be any accreditation cases for presentation at this meeting. Therefore, for those cases, the course of action recommended by the AP will be adopted.
