Our many clients, with whom we have contract to include their projects as CPA, wants to involve in Modalities of communication for their respective CPA. They want to involve as one of the focal point of contact for their respective CPA along with EKI Energy Services Ltd. they want focal points for (a)Communicate in relation to requests for forwarding of CER, (b) Communicate in relation to requests for addition and/or voluntary withdrawal of project participants and focal points, as well as changes to company names, legal status, contact details and specimen signatures and

	<p>(c)Communicate on all other project or programme related matters not covered by (a) or (b) above.</p> <p>We understand that Currently there is single MoC approach where authority can be distributed as sole, joint or shared for whole PoA level. It is not possible to have separate MoC for CPA level so that we can distribute focal point authority to our client for their CPA only. Offcourse being CME/PP or by default EKI Energy Services Ltd will be one of focal point of contact for all CPAs.</p> <p>We propose below two approach for Modalities of Communication for PoA projects First Approach -- Current procedure where for all CPA should have single MoC if CME do not wish to follow MoC update at CPA level. Second Approach -- CME should give flexibility to have MoC at CPA level. This is voluntary approach for CME and it is up to CME to follow this approach or not. If CME opt to follow this approach each CPA should have separate MoC.</p> <p>There are many investors who want to include their project as CPA but want to ensure to have one of the focal point for CER transaction (like forwarding of CERs) to secure their project under PoA. Though we can make contract with investor regarding project activity as per PoA requirement, but still these clients/investors do not want to proceed unless they involve in MoC. We understand that being as Investor, their concern is valid and hence we requesting UNFCCC to look into this matter and allow to follow second approach on a Voluntary basis (if CME wants to do so).</p> <p>We request UNFCCC guidance how we can ensure multiple clients/investors to secure their involvement for their respective CPA only. We are getting such request from many of our clients, hence we proposing second approach as a voluntary for CME.</p>
