### **Agenda item 3.1. Standards/tools**

#### **(a). Standards for CDM project activities and programmes of activities**

7. The MP recommended to approve the draft SB “TSB0015: Baseline woody biomass consumption and fNRB for household cookstoves in Myanmar” and requested the secretariat to forward it for consideration by the Board, after receiving the agreement from the Designated National Authority (DNA) of Myanmar. The work is based on the approval from the Board at its 102<sup>nd</sup> meeting on the request by the DNA of Myanmar to develop a top-down SB. The SB is to provide fraction of non-renewable biomass (fNRB) values for Myanmar which can be used by project activities/programme of activities (PoAs) applying methodologies such as “AMS-I.E: Switch from non-renewable biomass for thermal applications by the user” and “AMS-II.G: Energy efficiency measures in thermal applications of non-renewable biomass”. The MP noted that the SB will be processed and concluded according to applicable procedures.
