- 1. The CDM-Executive Board decided to reject the proposed request for issuance for CDM programme of activities "PoA for the Reduction of emission from non-renewable fuel from cooking at household level" for the monitoring period of 28 May 2014 2 May 2017 (7359-MP1-IRP1) on 12 January 2022, in accordance with the "CDM project cycle procedure of programme of activities" (PCP-PoA) version 02.0, paragraph 261. Further, in accordance with paragraph 271 of the PCP-PoA ver. 02, the ruling shall contain the facts and any interpretation of the facts that formed the basis of the proposed ruling, the CDM rules and requirements applied to the facts and the interpretation of the CDM rules and requirements as applied to the facts, which are as follows:
 - (a) The DOE (KBS Certification Services Pvt. Ltd, KBS) failed to verify that the sampling of the monitoring parameters has been implemented in accordance with the monitoring plan, as per VVS-PoA ver. 02 paragraph 346.
 - (b) The relevant requirement is VVS-PoA ver. 02 paragraph 346 that states "The DOE shall determine whether the monitoring of parameters related to GHG emission reductions or net anthropogenic GHG removals in the included CPA-DDs has been implemented in accordance with the registered monitoring plan".
 - (c) The reason and rationale for the final decision is:
 - (i) The sampling of the monitoring parameters was not conducted in accordance with the monitoring plan, as:
 - a. the CME conducted the survey monitoring on 85 households instead of the correct sample size of 149.1 households as required by the registered monitoring plan; and
 - b. the application of the lower bound to correct the estimate, as per paragraph 17 of the applied methodology (AMS-I.E. ver. 4), is only applicable when the CME has conducted the sampling as per registered monitoring plan and the estimates from the correct samples (i.e. 149.1 households) fail to achieve the target minimum level of precision.
- 2. In accordance with paragraph 278 of the PCP-PoA ver. 2.0, the DOE may re-submit the request for issuance with revised documentation if the reasons for the rejection can be addressed by means of a revised verification report, based on a revised monitoring report as appropriate.
